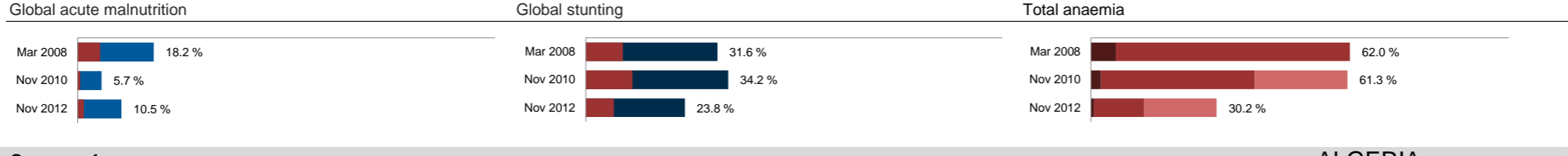

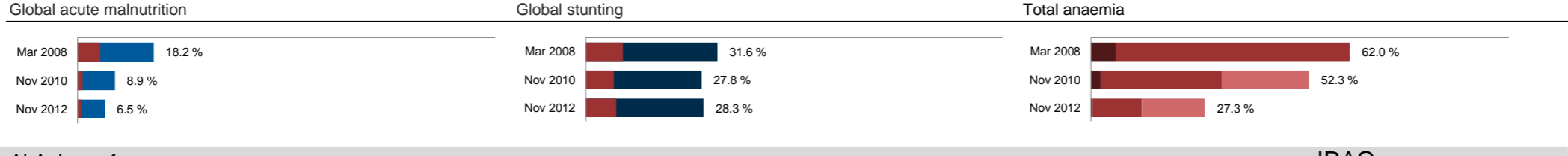

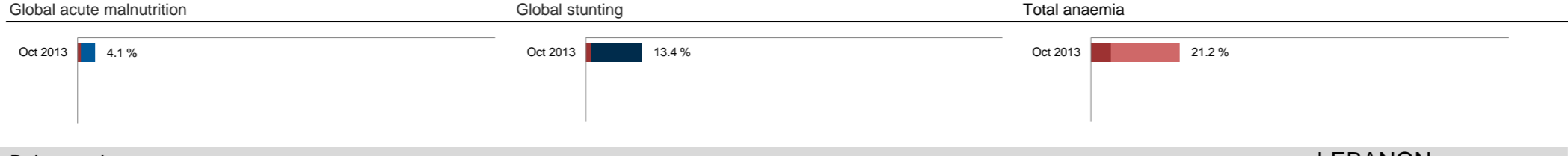

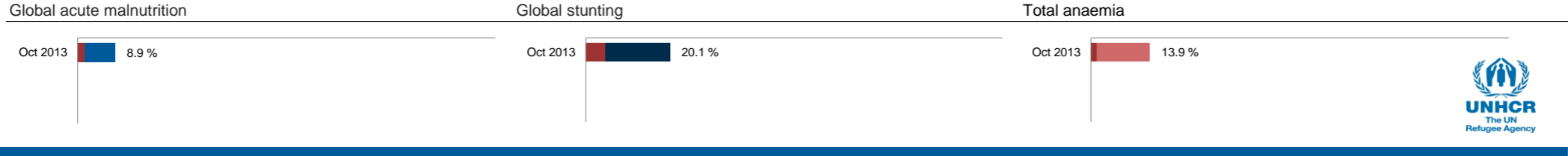

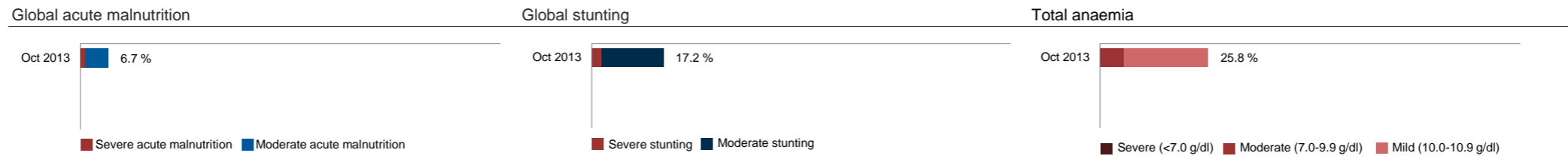

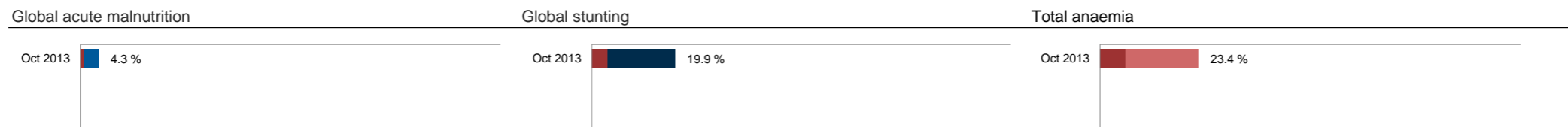

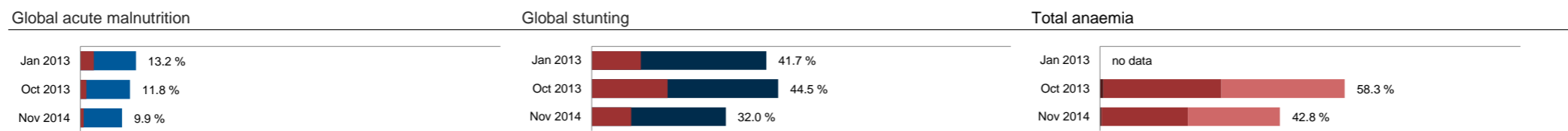

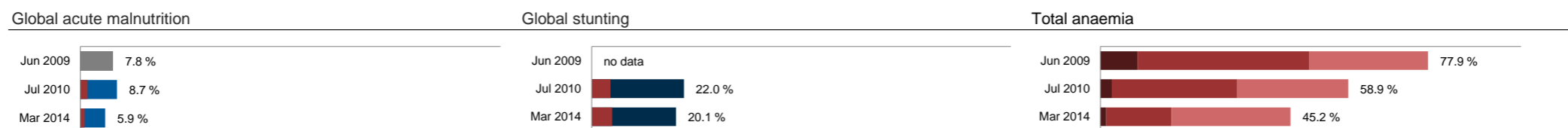

Comments

Targets for nutritional indicators: Global acute malnutrition <10% Stunting <20% Anaemia <20%

- In all four camps in Algeria, the results from 2008 represent aggregated data from Auserd, Dajhla, Layounne and Smara, and the results from 2008 for moderate anaemia includes both moderate and mild anaemia. For the Smara refugee camp, the results from 2012 also includes the Boujdour camp.

- In the 2009 result of global acute malnutrition in Kharaz (Yemen), data on moderate and severe acute malnutrition were not available, thus global acute malnutrition is presented with a bar in grey.
