


Comments

Targets for nutritional indicators: Global acute malnutrition <10%    Stunting <20%    Anaemia <20%

- For the Bwagiriza camp in Burundi, the results from 2010 also include the Buture refugee camp.

- For the Buduburam camp in Ghana, the 2010 results also include data from the Gomoa East District. For the 2011 anaemia results, there are no data on mild, moderate and severe anaemia, thus total anaemia is presented with a grey bar.

- In all four camps in Liberia, the survey results from 2012 represent aggregated data from the Bahn, PTP, Solo and Little Wlebo refugee camps.

- In all three camps in Rwanda, the survey results from 2011 represent aggregated data from the Gihembe, Nyabiheke and Kiziba refugee camps.

- In both camps in Tanzania, data from 2010 on severe stunting were not available, thus the results for global stunting in 2010 are presented with bars in grey.
